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Introduction

Colorado Department of Education (CDE) rules require each school district to complete an end-of-year (EOY) membership report that provides information on dropouts, graduates, active students, and withdrawals. This report provides information on graduates and completers, based on data submitted to the Colorado Department of Education for the 2004-2005 school year.

A graduate is a student who has received a traditional diploma. A completer is a student who has received either a traditional diploma or has earned a GED.

Beginning with the 1990-1991 school year, Denver Public Schools reported graduation and completer rates using formulas developed by CDE.

- Regular schools: the number of graduates or completers (graduates plus GED recipients and other completers) is divided by the adjusted grade 9 enrollment from four years earlier. Adjustments to this cohort's enrollment are made for incoming transfers, outgoing transfers, dropouts returning to the district, and dropouts whose records are requested by other school districts.
- Alternative schools: the number of graduates or completers is divided by the initial membership in grade 12, adjusted for incoming and outgoing transfers.

Graduates

For the 2004-2005 school year, the district had 2,938 completers including 2,777 graduates and 161 students who earned Graduate Equivalency Diplomas (GED). Table A presents graduate and completer information for 2003-2004 and 2004-2005. Official October membership percentages by ethnic group for 2005-2006 students are provided for the purpose of comparison.

For the district, the graduation rate was 68.0%, and the completer rate was 72.0%. Table B provides the graduation and completer rates for each ethnic group for 2004-2005. Tables 1, 2, 3, and 4 (attached) provide comparable information about earlier years.

Tables 1 and 2 (attached) provide information on graduates and graduation rates at each high school and alternative school. Tables 3 and 4 (attached) provide comparable information about completers.

Of the traditional high schools, nine schools showed a drop in graduation rates.

- Abraham Lincoln's graduation rate decreased the most (35.1%), and reported the lowest graduation rate (43.5%).

*Beginning in 2004-2005 CDE determined that students enrolled in the College Now program would be treated as retentions, and therefore excluded from the graduation base and not counted as graduates.

- Millennium Quest showed a decrease of 14.2% from 2003-2004 to 2004-2005.
- North showed a decrease in rate of 10.1%.
- Leadership Academy's graduation rate decreased 7.9% in 2004-2005. In 2003-2004 Leadership Academy's graduation rate decreased the most (15.6%).
- John F. Kennedy's graduation rate decreased 4.1%.
- East and George Washington both showed decreases of 2.6.
- Thomas Jefferson's graduation rate decreased slightly (0.1%).

The remaining traditional high schools, four showed an increase in their graduation rates.

- South had the highest increase in graduation rate (5.4%).
- Denver School of the Arts had the highest 2004-2005 graduation rate of 97.4%, a 0.8% increase in rate from 2003-2004.
- Montbello showed a graduation rate increase of 3.0%.
- Arts and Cultural Studies' graduation rate increased by 0.5%.

Caution must be exercised when comparing the number of graduates in different districts as the graduation requirements established by local school boards may vary, many do not require pupils to complete as many credits as required by the Denver Public Schools.

The graduation and completer rates are conservative estimates of the true graduation rate because no adjustment is made for twelfth grade dropouts who return to school or other dropouts who complete their education as adults.
