Student Transfers

The Student Transfers Report shows the number of students who chose to attend a school other than the school that serves their residence, including students who are not residents of the City and County of Denver. The report identifies the students in three choice categories: non-Residents of the City and County of Denver who chose to attend a Denver Public School (DPS); Denver residents who requested a school that does not serve their residence; Denver residents who chose to attend a school other than their residence school.

Table 1 is a summary of the number of transfers by program.

Tables 2 thru 5 show the number of students attending a school that is not the school that serves their residence. The area membership column shows the number of students who reside in the neighborhood the respective school serves. Magnet schools do not serve a specific residential area so they have no area membership number. These schools are denoted with a single asterisk. The October 1 Membership column shows the number of students enrolled in the respective school on October 1. A "transfer out" is a student who transfers from the school that serves their residence to attend another DPS school. A "transfer in" is a student who transfers to a DPS school that is not the school that serves their residence.

Table 6 gives the count of students choosing to transfer into a school that does not serve their residence. The count is by the program the student chooses to attend.

Table 7 gives the count of students choosing to transfer out of the school that serves their residence. The count is by the program the student chooses to attend.

The Non-Resident tables 8 through 12 show the number of students at each school who are not residents of the City and County of Denver based on their residence address. A non-resident is a person who does not reside within the Denver City and County lines. These students chose to attend DPS instead of a school that serves the city and county they reside in.
